



RULES AND REGULATIONS 2022

ART. 1 - ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

The A.S.D. Cadini Promotion, in collaboration with the Municipality of Auronzo di Cadore, the Alpine Rescue Team, the Italian Alpine Club, and the Tourist Association Tre Cime Dolomiti, organizes on September, 10th 2022 the 4th edition of the Diavolo Vertical Sprint - Tre Cime Experience by Scarpa®, a 1,5 km vertical race with 400 m+ (variation in altitude, m.a.s.l.), starting from the Camping “Alla Baita” in Misurina and following the old lift “Torre del Diavolo”.

ART. 2 - ACCEPTANCE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

All athletes who register to participate in the Diavolo Vertical Sprint accept all rules and regulations of this agreement. Entering this competition, athletes must follow the rules and regulations, thus exempting the Organizing Committee from any liability for accidents, personal injuries, property or people damages, which they may suffer or cause during the event. The Diavolo Vertical Sprint will take place according to these rules and regulations and all changes, updates and news will be published on the website www.trecimeexperience.com. In all matters not expressly provided, the ISF (International Skyrunning Federation) rules and regulations shall be applied.

ART. 3 - PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

All athletes who choose to run the COMPETITIVE race must be 18 years old on race day and must provide a regular and valid certificate attesting their good state of health, together with their signed waiver of responsibility, when collecting their race bib numbers. Athletes who have been disqualified for using performance-enhancement drugs will not be accepted.

There will also be a NON-COMPETITIVE race open to anybody, and no health certificate is required for this.

Athletes who run the NON-COMPETITIVE race will only need the waiver of responsibility, signed by a guardian in case the athlete is under the age of 18.



ART. 4 - REGISTRATION

Registration is open on race day only from 2 pm to 3 pm at the Tre Cime Experience tent by the Torre del Diavolo lift in Misurina. Each participant will have to sign the waiver of responsibility provided.

ART. 5 - REGISTRATION FEES

Registration fee is €15 for the Diavolo Vertical Sprint. For those already registered also for the Misurina Sky Marathon or the Cadini Sky Race the fee is €10. Registration fees include assistance throughout the race, refreshments at the finish line, meal coupons, and a gadget.

ART. 6 - START OF THE RACE

The meeting point is at 3:15 pm by the former lift “Torre del Diavolo”, next to Camping “Alla Baita”. After the briefing, athletes will run their race one at a time every 30 seconds starting at 3:30 pm.

ART. 7 - REFRESHMENTS AND WAY BACK

At the finish line, hot drinks will be available. Participants can walk back down on the same way or following another track indicated by the Organizing Committee. There will be a buffet for athletes at the Camping “Alla Baita”.

ART. 8 - INSURANCE

The Organizing Committee will provide and subscribe a liability disclaimer form for the entire duration of the race. Each participant is entirely responsible by taking part to the race, thus releasing the Organizing Committee from any liability in case of damages to people/things or other consequences occurring during or after the race.



ART. 9 - RACE ROUTE OR TIME LIMITS CHANGES - CANCELLATION OF THE RACE

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify at any time the race route and/or rescue and refreshments stops. In case of bad and adverse weather conditions (dense fog, snow or thunder storms) and in order to avoid potential hazards and risks for competitors, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel the start of the race, to modify or to reduce the race route and to stop the race at any time.

ART. 10 - RESULTS AND PRIZES

Only athletes enrolled in the COMPETITIVE race who will register at the finish line will figure in the final results. There will be a ranking for men and women and prizes will be awarded to the first 5 men and 5 women of the general ranking.

The times of the athletes enrolled in the NON-COMPETITIVE race will be published, but there will be no ranking.

ART. 11 - IMAGE USE POLICY

By entering the competition each participant authorizes the Organizing Committee to use any images taken at any time during the race.
